

Statement of Cooperation

It is my desire to have my child enrolled in Risen Son Christian School (RSCS) and/or the Eagles Nest Daycare (END). Attending RSCS or END is a privilege, not a right. I have read, understand, and agree for myself and my child that we will follow the school's policies, procedures, and requirements contained in the Registration Materials and the Student handbook. If my child is accepted, we will cooperate with the school in having our child educated in accordance with the Christian philosophy set forth there in. It is my understanding that the policy of the school is to make no refunds on registration fees. I give permission for my child to participate in all activities and events including bus trips, sports, and school-sponsored trips away from the school premises, and absolve the school from all liability of me or my child because of injury to my child at school or during any school activity or event. I also believe that discipline is necessary for the welfare of each student, as well as the entire school. I give permission for my child's teacher and or agents of the school to make and enforce classroom regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles and discipline as set forth in the Scriptures. I further agree to hold the school and its agents harmless for any liability for my child or any guardian or parent thereof because of any injury to my child. Should legal action for any reason be taken against RSCS or END or any employee or agent thereof on my child's behalf and the school, daycare, employee, or agent are not found to be at fault, I agree to pay any Attorney fees, court fees, damages, or any other costs that RSCS or END, or its agents should incur to defend itself against such action. I understand that RSCS or END does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in admissions or administration of any of its policies or programs.

I have read the information materials furnished by RSCS/END and I agree to insist that my child submit to its program, academic, and disciplinary regulations and all other requirements instituted by the Administration and carried out by the Principle and Faculty.
